

Does this qualify for the Gold Project?

The flow chart below can be used to help decide whether your choice of residential activity meets the requirements for the Gold Award.

Will you be away from home for a minimum of five days and four nights, and do you have a the Gold Project. Your Award Leader can clarify the requirements and help you find an opportunity that Talk to your Award Leader about this opportunity. It is specified Assessor?
