Thank you for agreeing to be an Assessor for The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award ('The Award'). The Assessor is an essential part of the accountability of the Award program.

The main role of the Assessor is to be knowledgeable in the activity of that Award section and verify the Participant's progress towards meeting their SMART goal set as part of the Award framework. As an Assessor, the Participant may look to you for guidance in setting a realistic goal at the beginning of their Award journey, as well as instruction and encouragement to complete the activity.

Assessor's Responsibilities:

- Agree to follow Award USA Code of Conduct.
- Provide feedback on Award Participant's SMART goal for their Award activity.
- Monitor the Participant's progress and regular commitment.
- Complete a brief report upon Participant completing their required time working on the Award activity to verify their progress and participation.
