With the support and guidance of an Award Leader mentor, participants achieve an internationally recognized credential and develop essential life skills that are exactly what universities and employers look for in applicants. **The virtual Open Award Center makes the program accessible to young people across the United States!**

Time Required: Minimum 6 months

Age: 15+ years

Time Required: Minimum 12 months



Gold

Age: 16+ years

Time Required: Minimum 18 months

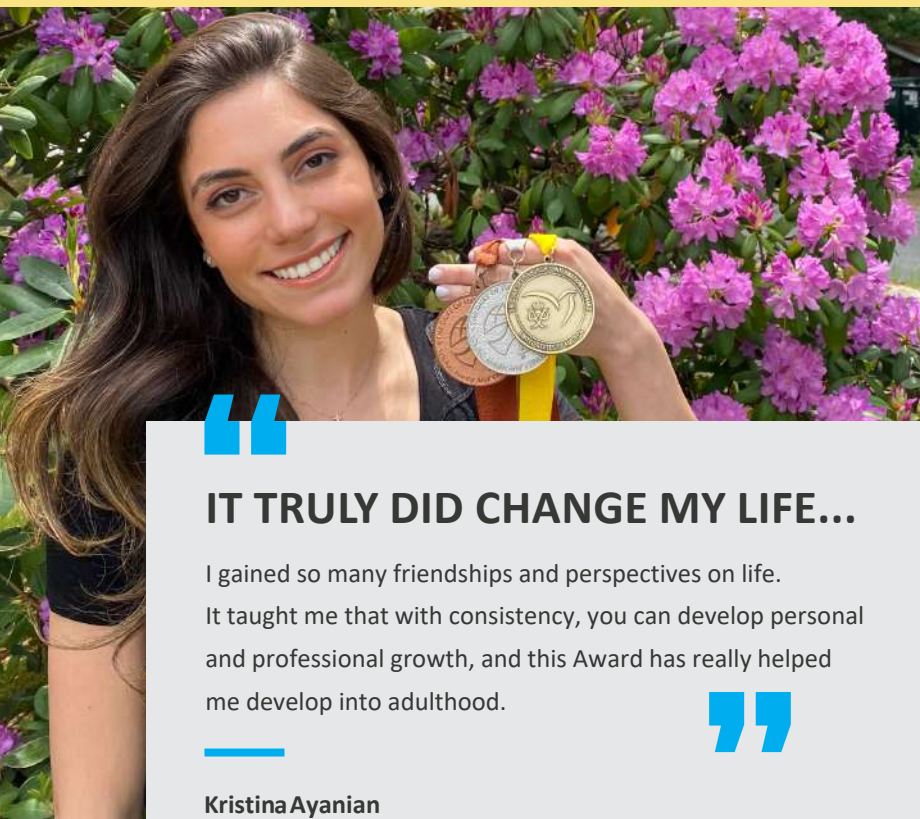
